I Corinthians 15:1-11



*“and if Christ has not been raised,
your faith is worthless; you are still
in your sins.”*

I Corinthians 15:17



Faith comes by hearing & hearing by the Word! (vs.1-2)

- What difference does this day make in your life?
- Paul is teaching the Corinthians to stand firm in their faith in Jesus Christ.
- Acts 4:12 says, “*And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.*”

The Bible declares the Gospel throughout! (vs.3-4)

- The “Scripture” Paul is referring to in this passage is the “Old Testament”.
- Look at Leviticus 16:5, 10, 15, 20-22
- These verses demonstrate God’s forgiveness for our sins.
- Christ died for your sin and mine!
- Is He Lord of your life today?

History records that there are many witnesses of Christ's resurrection!

(vs.5-11)

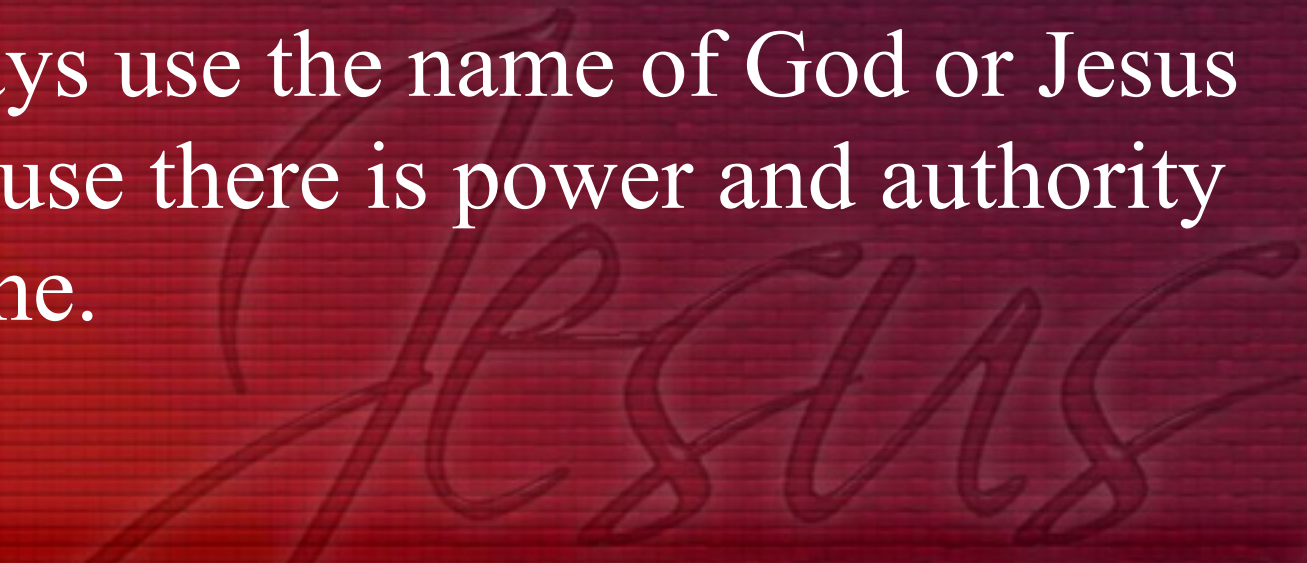
- He appeared to Peter & the other disciples.
- He appeared to over 500 people!
- He appeared to His half-brother, James.
- He appeared to Paul on the Road to Damascus.

Acts 4:10-12

“Let it be known to all of you and all the people in Israel; that by the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead...He is the stone which was rejected by you, the builders, but which became the Chief Corner Stone. And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.”

There is only One Savior!

- Have you ever noticed that no one ever says:
 - “What in Allah’s name is going on?”
 - No one ever Texts “OMB”, “Oh My Buddha”.
 - “Muhammed”
- People always use the name of God or Jesus Christ, because there is power and authority in Their name.
